RANKINGS

Anticipating and accommodating academic and business needs of higher paying jobs in targeted industries is paying off for Tampa Bay's two largest counties (Hillsborough and Pinellas). They lead Florida's major metropolitan areas in average wage gain over the past ten years:

- Hillsborough County experienced the greatest whole number average wage increase (\$9,552) among Florida's most populous counties over the ten-year period 2007-2016. Pinellas County ranked second (\$9,194)
- Hillsborough County experienced the second-highest percentage gain (23.2%) among Florida's most populous counties over the ten-year period 2007-2016; Pinellas County ranked first (24.6%)
- Between 2015-2016, Hillsborough County had the highest average wage increase of Florida's seven largest metro areas (\$1,061 or 2.1%)
- Hillsborough County had the state's second-highest average annual wage (\$50,768) of Florida's most populous counties in 2016, the year for which most recent ES202 data is available
